Please be advised that on Wednesday, December 26, 2018, at 4:00 P.M. prevailing time, at the Pocopson Township Building, 740 Denton Hollow Road, West Chester, PA 19382, the Pocopson Township Board of Supervisors will hold a special meeting to conduct a public hearing to consider, and immediately thereafter during its special meeting decide whether or not to adopt, an ordinance titled: "AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF POCOPSON, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CREATING A NEW CHAPTER "SPECIAL EVENTS" WHICH PROVIDES FOR DEFINITIONS, PERMITS, A PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION AND TOWNSHIP REVIEW, REQUIREMENTS, FEES AND COSTS, REVOCATION OF A PERMIT, APPEALS, **VIOLATIONS AND** PENALTIES, RECORDS. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS CONTAINED HEREIN." Section 1 creates a new special events chapter which provides for definitions, and requirements related to special event permits, application procedures, township review, requirements, fees and costs, revocation of permits, appeals, violations and penalties, and records. Section 2 provides for severability if any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional, illegal, or otherwise invalid. Section 3 repeals all ordinances or parts of ordinance conflicting or inconsistent herewith. Section 4 permits General Code to make nonsubstantive formatting and numbering changes. Section 5 provides for the Ordinance to become effective five days after enactment. The Board may also consider and act upon fee and rate resolutions related to the proposed ordinance. A complete copy of the proposed Ordinance may be examined and copies obtained (for the cost of reproducing same) at the Township Building, Monday through Friday, 9:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. In addition, attested copies of the Ordinance are on file at the Daily Local News, 390 Eagleview Blvd., Exton, PA 19341 and the Chester County Law Library, 201 W. Market Street, Suite 2400, West Chester, PA 19380 where the same can be examined without charge.
